- placing tables in a "U" shape around the gym
- removing all octagon tables from H-14, and ten trapezoid tables from H-3
- putting chairs out at the tables, and caution tape around the flight line
- running electrical lines from the outlets to four locations in the gym
- setting up a registration table in the lobby, as well as signs directing visitors
- setting up a simulator station and a projector with it.

The afternoon funfly clean up will involve a massive 'Ctrl+Z' (that's the undo shortcut). It is my clean-up-goal to leave the high school by 5pm. The rented tables are due back by 5:30pm.
